

Sr.No	Additional conditions for EoI
1	The Applicant (Parent and/or Subsidiary) must have an average annual turnover of INR 10 Cr. for the last 3(three) 2014-15, 2015-16, & 2016-17 audited financial years.
2	The Applicant (Parent and/or Subsidiary) must have manufactured and installed at least 10,000 GPS/VTD/VTS in the last 5 years from the date of publication of the document.
3	The Applicant must have a pan India Service Network.
4	The Bidder should have service network in Bihar and support centers/logistics support for the entire state.
5	Applicant should have experience of Supply, Installation, and maintenance of 3000 No GPS/GPRS based Vehicle tracking unit in a single Project.
6	Applicant must have AIS 140 certification for its products from any of the test agencies under Rule 126 of the Central Motor Vehicle Rules (CMVR).
7	Support Letter from GPS chipset Manufacturer.
8	The bidder must have a positive net worth. [Measured as (Subscribed and Paid-up Equity + Reserves) less (Revaluation reserves+ miscellaneous expenditure not written off+ reserves not available for distribution to equity shareholders)] in last financial year i.e 2016-17.
